WATHI IS LOOKING FOR VOLUNTEERS IN WEST AFRICA (THE 15 MEMBER COUNTRIES OF ECOWAS + MAURITANIA, CHAD AND CAMEROON) AND WITHIN THE DIASPORA

WATHI is a participatory, open and multidisciplinary think tank that aims to contribute to the sharing of knowledge and the production of ideas on crucial political, economic, social and cultural issues for the present and the future of West African countries. The geographical area of WATHI includes the 15 member countries of ECOWAS as well as Cameroon, Chad and Mauritania.

WATHI is looking for volunteers living in any of the 18 countries of the WATHI Zone, or their diaspora around the world, to support the permanent team of Dakar in:

1. Content production (text and multimedia) for its website, the knowledge sharing platform www.wathi.org
 2. Revision of articles and translation from French into English, English into French, Portuguese into French, Portuguese into English, and French or English into Portuguese
 3. The launch and facilitation of activities conform to WATHI's mindset in each of the countries in the region, including discussion clubs in academic and professional spaces.
- ❖ The type of remote collaboration is determined by mutual agreement between the WATHI's permanent team and the selected volunteer, following direct exchanges, based on the needs of WATHI, the skills and interests of the volunteer.
 - ❖ Volunteers who contribute to content published by WATHI will have their name and the nature of their contribution (interviews, articles, videos, photos, translations, etc.) mentioned on the publication. Facilitation of discussion clubs and other volunteering activities will also be relayed on WATHI's website and social networks.

- ❖ WATHI volunteers must be very proficient (oral and written) in French, English or Portuguese (in the latter case, a basic knowledge of French or English is also required).
- ❖ They must be very familiar with the use of the Internet for information research and communication purposes. An interest in making videos and/or photography will be considered an asset.
- ❖ WATHI volunteers must above all be curious and passionate about political, economic, social or cultural issues that are important for the present and the future of their respective countries, for West Africa in particular and Africa in general.
- ❖ The WATHI Volunteer program is open permanently and there is no long-term commitment from volunteers or WATHI.
- ❖ Those identified by WATHI for specific collaboration will be contacted as needed. The WATHI team does not have the means to respond individually to all expressions of interest and will only contact those selected.
- ❖ Resumes must include a few lines of introduction mentioning the interests, education and/or experience as well as the desired type of collaboration with WATHI among the three options presented above.
